

The Carbon County Fair is looking for non-profit groups for the following tasks during the Carbon County Fair, August 2-9, 2025: This is the biggest week of the year for Carbon County! If your group is interested in being a part of the excitement, this is what is available:

1. Concessionaire:

The Concession Stand is an integral part of Fair Week. Party interested should be open mid morning through end of evening events the entire week of Fair. Our past concessionaire was able to have different High School groups work alongside them and raise money for different clubs/organizations at the High School. This is a very demanding week. You will be able to determine your own menu. There are also Food Trucks on the grounds during Fair Week. You are responsible for ordering your own food/supplies necessary, also. You will give the Fair Board a percentage of your earnings.

2. Ticket Takers:

Ticket Takers work all ticketed events. This is Wednesday and Thursday night events, and the duration of the Demolition Derby on Saturday. Group must be able to supply at least 6-8 people to man the booths. Hours are 4 p.m. to approximately 8:30 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday, and 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Saturday of the Derby. Must be able to run ticket scanners and take care of cash box. This pays \$1,200.00.

3. Housekeeping:

During Fair Week, restrooms and shower house must be cleaned three times daily. Restrooms in Multi Plex, Beer Stand, Exhibit Hall, need to be cleaned, as well as the shower house. Showers must be cleaned and ready prior to 7:00 a.m. daily, and evenings at 4:00 p.m. every evening. Group size must be large enough to split up between all the buildings. This pays \$2,500.00.

4. Security:

Security is provided from Saturday August 2 through Saturday, August 9. Security personnel will be on duty from 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. daily, and will also meet with the Fair Board at 6:00 a.m. each morning to discuss any issues that arise. Barns, and grounds will all need to be patrolled all night. This pays \$3000.00.

5. Beer Stand:

The Beer Stand is open and running at 4:00 p.m. each day during Fair Week. You will need to stay 30 minutes after each evenings' events are over. This group is responsible for ordering their own merchandise and doing their bookkeeping each night. There is a split between the nonprofit and the Fair Board. This group is also responsible for cleaning the grandstands every night. You will give the Fair Board a percentage of your earnings.
